## Conditions specific to manufacture, supply, install or adapt gambling software

This licence is subject to the condition that:
(a) the licensee must not manufacture, supply, install or adapt gambling software other than for use in connection with gambling facilities provided by the licensee; and
(b) the licensee must not incur costs of more than $£ 50,000$ per annum for the purpose of carrying out activities authorised by the licence.
